Extra security helps keep your transactions safe

By now, you should have received your new TruGrocer VISA® Credit Card with a computer chip for enhanced security. In this era of heightened concerns about financial fraud, the new cards should help you feel more secure when making purchases because chip cards are more difficult to counterfeit or copy.

Here are some tips to help you adjust to the change:

1. Your new VISA card has a new card number, so your old card will no longer work and should be destroyed.
2. The new card has a square area on the front containing the computer chip that helps authenticate transactions.
3. Unlike the old "black stripe" cards, your new card generates a unique code for each transaction. This makes it more difficult for criminals to use your information to commit fraud. You may still use the card in machines that only take mag the stripe.
4. To use your card, swipe or insert it into the retailer's terminal and then follow the prompts. In some cases, you still must provide your signature or PIN.

Tip: Your new card comes with the same benefits as your previous card, **including an annual 1 percent rebate on your net purchases** (excluding cash advances).

eStatements are the safe, easy, green way to go! With eStatements, you'll never have to wait to receive paper statements by mail; instead, you can view an electronic image of your statement via your CU OnLine account.

You will receive your eStatement at the same frequency as your current mailed statement, and you'll receive an electronic notification (usually near the beginning of each month) to inform you that your eStatement is available. To get eStatements, log onto your CU OnLine account today and select "eStatement signup."



Beware of scams targeting older adults

Every day, criminals defraud older adults of millions of dollars by stealing their identity and financial information. The problem is not that older adults are easy to fool. Rather, it is that criminals make it hard for even the most cautious person to identify scams.

To help protect assets belonging to an elderly loved one:


- **Watch for signs of neglect or coercion.** Older adults are vulnerable to threats, and abusive caregivers may demand large sums of money in exchange for providing food or care.
- **Be alert to theft.** Because they need more care, elderly people may be more easily victimized by those who come into the home for a legitimate reason but steal or "borrow" property while there.
- **Watch investments.** Sometimes, older adults can be easily persuaded into putting money toward risky (or nonexistent) investments or business ventures.



- **Stay informed.** Organizations such as the National Council on Aging (ncoa.org) and the Financial Fraud Enforcement Task Force (stopfraud.gov) are great resources to learn about scams.
